PUBLIC HEALTH ENGINEER 2 or CIVIL ENGINEER 2 Start at \$748. Earn raises to \$973.  
PUBLIC HEALTH ENGINEER 3 or CIVIL ENGINEER 3 Start at \$813. Earn raises to \$1058.  
The department may give salary recognition at the time of appointment to applicants who have additional appropriate training and experience. The starting salary may not exceed \$868 for the 2 level and \$948 for the 3 level.

Recent expansion in the Department of Resource Development has broadened the opportunities for engineers. Engineers are needed in the central office of the Water Resources Division in Madison within the following sections: Water Supply, Water Quality Planning and Control, Wastewater Treatment, Land Use and Water Management, and Research. In addition, positions are available within geographic regions with headquarters at Madison, Milwaukee, Green Bay, Wisconsin Rapids and Eau Claire.

DUTIES: Plan and organize assigned stream and industrial waste surveys. Compile data; prepare reports, and appear as a technical witness before public hearings or the courts. Consult with industrial and local officials on remedial procedures to be followed to correct water pollution. Participate in studies of sewer systems and sewage treatment facilities; inspect facilities to determine whether installation is in accordance with approved plans and specifications. Review plans and specifications for water supply improvements or sewerage facilities; consult with engineers on plans for water supply facilities or sewerage facilities and provide alternatives in design. Consult and correspond with well drillers and pump installers to insure compliance with laws and codes; check construction reports and make field investigations of private water supply installations; inspect high capacity well installations.

Each engineer may not perform all duties, but various tasks may be combined in different proportions.

ELIGIBILITY will be based on an evaluation of training and experience.

APPLICATION: Send your application to the Bureau of Personnel. Upon receipt of your application the Bureau will evaluate your training and experience. Eligible candidates will be contacted by the Department for interviews.
