REGIONAL DIRECTORS

Water Resources Division, Department of Resource Development

Start at \$968 a month. Earn \$50 raise after six months. Further merit raises to \$1258. The department may give salary recognition at the time of appointment to applicants who have additional appropriate training and experience. Starting salary may not exceed \$1068.

LOCATIONS: A Director will be appointed for each of the five regions, with headquarters in Eau Claire, Green Bay, Madison, Milwaukee and Wisconsin Rapids. The list established at this time will be used to fill these vacancies only.

DUTIES: Serve as a representative of the Department of Resource Development in the assigned region. Be responsible for the orderly development of basin wide surveys, comprehensive river basin plans, and programming of municipal and industrial waste studies. Represent the Department on the regional advisory board and participate in the development of water quality standards, advise municipal officials on the Federal and State assistance programs, and consult with officials and consulting engineers on waste treatment needs required to meet standards.

QUALIFICATIONS: Training and experience - Graduation from a college or university and six years of progressively responsible experience in the fields of engineering, water pollution control or natural resources management; three years of which involved work in a water resources management program including some supervisory or administrative responsibility. Wisconsin residence is not required.

Essential skills and knowledges - Thorough knowledge of the principles and techniques of public health related to water pollution. Ability to formulate, interpret and enforce policies and regulations; to delegate authority and fix responsibility; and to direct and administer a program within an assigned region. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with executive, legislative, departmental and public representation.
