This is highly responsible administrative and advanced technical work of a professional nature directing, organizing and supervising the statewide water resources program of the Department of Resource Development. The work is performed with a high degree of independence within the framework of laws, rules and general policy established by the Department Director. The list established from this examination will be used to fill this vacancy only.

DUTIES: Administer general departmental policies; report to the Department Director on plans and activities of the division; coordinate and organize staff's work and procedures, including training, discipline and morale. Administer state and federal financial aids programs for water pollution control. Prepare a long-range comprehensive plan for the development, management and protection of the water resources in each geographic region of the state. Direct the establishment of water quality standards for all intra- and inter-state waters, and regulation of shorelands and flood plains. Supervise construction, maintenance and operation of institutional and public sewage collection and treatment, industrial waste treatment facilities and installation, maintenance and operation of public water supply systems. Direct licensing for all well drillers and pump installers and the certification of operators of public water supply and sewage systems. Direct the programs for stream and lake survey, chemical treatment, regulation of water levels and usage, structures in navigable waters, and related water resource work.

QUALIFICATIONS: Training and experience - College or university degree and eight years of progressively responsible experience in the fields of engineering, water pollution control or resources management, five years of which shall have included major program responsibilities. An equivalent combination of training and experience will be considered.
